## Week 17

In this for now last week of the Guipure laces you get 2 laces together.Lia Baumeister drew and made an edging and an insertion of the same design. So you can choose between them or make them both. that is up to you. For the edging you need 19 pairs of bobbins and for the insertion 24 pairs. They are made with DMC fil de dentelle 80 or linen 70/2.


To start it is the best to do that at the half stitch part. Start with 6 pairs and add lateron 2 pairs on each side. The braids at the sides consist of 5 pairs each. The other pairs are not difficult to start. The crossing in the centre of the insertion is a little bit complicated. It is a 8-pairs crossing of which 2 pairs are coming from each side. These pairs coming out of the braids are treated like plaits, so every bobbins is a pair. It is made like a 10-pairs crossing on the same way as a real 8-pairs crossing as in the drawing below.


In the edging is this crossing a extended7-pairs crossing. The workers of the braid are going to the other side of the edging and return to the braid. See the drawing below how to work the 7-pairs crossing.
