

## Week 39

The designer of this insertion is Bep Hoogerbrugge.

She brought in something new for this. The ground is a simple torchon ground with a star in the trangles. The gimps around the honeycomb are worked in stem stitch and along the edges in chainstitch.

You need 18 pairs of bobbins with linen 60/2 or similar and 6 pairs with coton perlé 8.





How to do the star:


Twist all pairs twice, cross pair 1 and 2, cross pair 3 and 4. 2 cloth stitches with the 3rd pair to the left and 2 cloth stitches with the 4th pair to the left. Cross pair 1 and 2, cross pair 3 and 4 and twist all pairs twice.



How to do the stem stitch: Work until the gimp pair. Twist that pair

once, lift the right bobbin and lay the workers under the right thread over the left thread to the other side. Do exactly the same on your way back. So lift the right bobbin and lay the workers | under the right thread over the lift thread to the other side.

When you like the stem stitch to go the other way around, you have to do everything in the opposite direction.





How to do the chain stitch:

Work unto the gimps. Lift the 2 outside threads, lay the workers under them over the centre threads. Lay the lifted threads back between the centre threads. Repeat this every time you have to make the chain stitch.

When you should like the chain stitch to go the other way around, do everything in the opposite direction. So lift the centre threads, lay the workers under the centre treads over the outside threads and lay the lifted threads back on the outside of the gimps.

A lot of 'difficulties' this time, but I am sure you will manage. Have fun!
