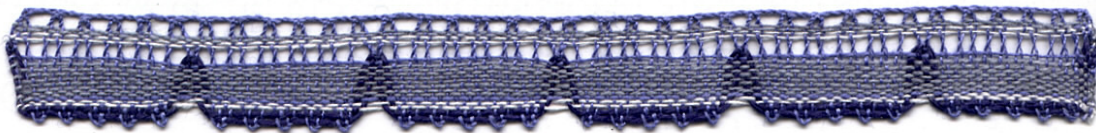


Week 20

This week we start with a series of Michailov laces. These originate from the region Riazan, Russia and are called after the city Michailov in that region. Originally they were used in the traditional costume and as decoration on tablecloths, etc. They were made in white or color, often with threads of different texture and thickness.

You need 9 pairs of bobbins with linen 40/2 and 1 pair with coton perlé 5 or threads of similar thickness.



Originally these laces were also made without a pattern and with pins only at the edges. To make it easy for you we made prickings.

This edging is made according to the thread diagram below:
