## Week 31

The second point ground lace has a straight edge at one side and a slightly scalloped edge at the other. In the ground are several small motifs.

You need 27 pairs of bobbins with Egyptian cotton 90/2 or similar and 2 pairs with a gimp ie. thread for buttonholes.


In the pricking only the gimps and de tallies are drawn to keep it clear. So the working diagram is very important.
The gimp is added always above a motif and taken out under it. This is done by crossing the pair with the gimp and lay the bobbins through 2 pairs along the motif upward and out of the work. After you have continued the ground the gimp is closed in firmly and can be cut.
