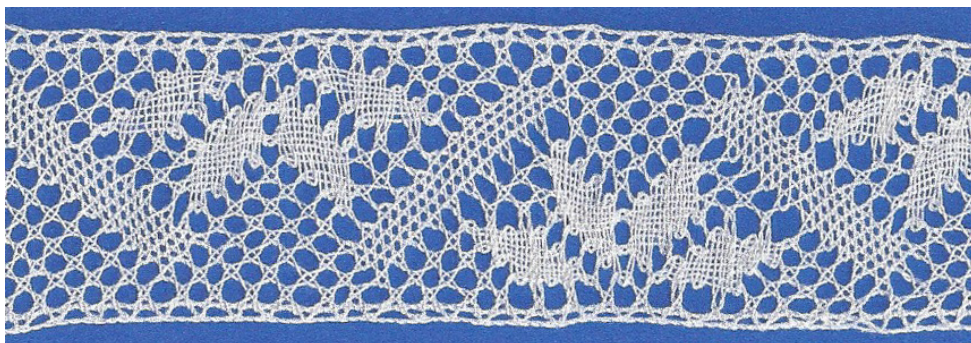


Week 38

The most important motif in this insertion is the half star flower, which shows in the Pettersson laces and also in the Skåne laces. Originally this lace is made on a pricking of only pinholes. On this pricking more than one lace can be made. The laceworker places the pins only there where the pattern requires it. This will be only at the edges and along the motifs. No pins in the ground. This means in this case only pins on the black dots, no pins on the grey dots in the ground. This insertion is designed for us by Bep Hoogerbrugge. You need 20 pairs of bobbins with linen 50/2 or 60/2 or similar



The pricking is very clear. Together with the photo it is easy to work from.
