


The next point ground insertion is designed and made by Ria de Ruiter. It is not very difficult. The gimp goes around the flower and the leaves and makes the stem. When you want no space between the cloth stitch of the flower and the leaves, do no twist between the cloth stich and the gimp. In de ground there are some tallies.

You need 26 pairs of bobbin with Egyptian coton 80/2 or similar and 2 pairs with a gimp, i.e. DMC embroidery coton nbr. 16.



The tally in the point ground is made according the drawing below. Important is that every tally in the lace is made the same way. This means that the worker starts every tally on the same side. Even more important is that the centre thread, which goes from one side to the other, is worked first into the ground or the next tally before you continue with the worker thread. This is to avoid the tally becomes too narrow at the end.
