


Week 51

This edging is also originally a design from pages published by the Lace society Het Molenwiekje. On these pages there are simply drawn patterns. Sometimes the amount of pairs of bobbins is mentioned, sometimes it is not. You have to decide yourself which stitches you are going to use. The designer of this edging is not mentioned. You need 22 pairs of bobbins with linen 60/2 or similar.



Of course you are free to use other stitches than we did. We thought that what we did was probably the same as the idea of the designer. I worked rounds in half stitch without a whole stitch at the outer edge. This is done often in the Dutch lace of this period. Although the edge is not as straight as it can be, I think it is also nice this way.
