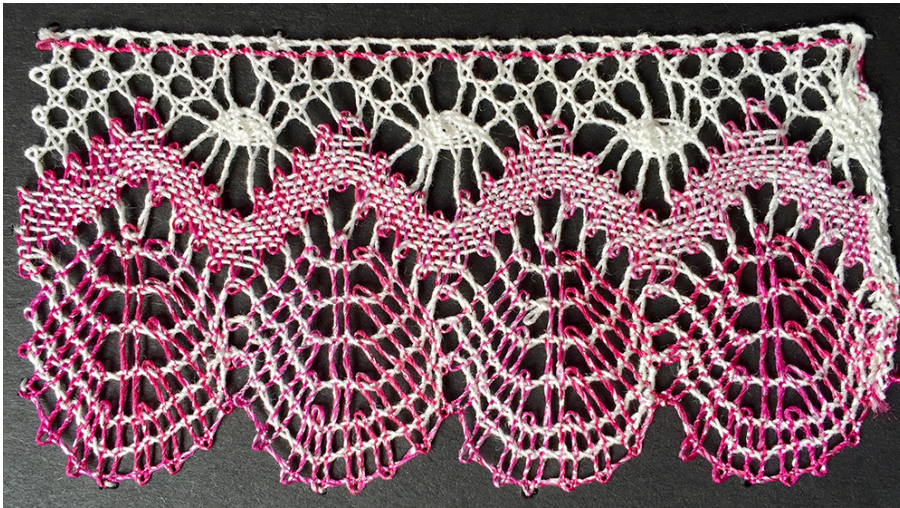


Week 6

The second Torchon edging is from Belgium. One of my students bought over there some handkerchiefs of which she wished to make the edgings. So I made for her and myself the prikkings and diagrams. Who designed them? I don't know. But they are beautiful and a great fun to make.

You need 19 pairs of bobbins with DMC fil de dentelle 80 or similar



In the Netherlands we call this long fan a prayer without ending, because you can make it as long as you wish. This type of fan is made mostly in whole stitch with an extra twist between the 2 hanging pairs at the outside.

Next to the straight edging is only 1 pair in whole stitch.

The spider is an normal spider with 6 legs. The legs should be twisted 3 times except for the longest two. These get an extra twist.

The zigzag braid can be made in cloth stitch or in half stitch, what you like most.
