Week 8

This week we have an Torchon edging with a curved edging in half stitch. The motifs in the ground are a diamond in cloth stitch and a spider with a hole. You need 30 pairs of bobbins with DMC fil a dentell 80 or similar.



You need Along the straight edge there is one pair in whole stitch. The last pair of the curved edge is also in whole stitch to get a beautiful edge.

The spirder with the hole is working according to the diagram. The amount of twists are the same as in the normal spider, namely the amount is twists is the same as the amount of legs in a quarter of the spider. In this case 4, so 4 twists except for the longest most horizontal leg. That need an extra twist, so 5 twists.

In diagrams in black and white in a motif or edge in half stitch only the place is shown where the hanging pairs go in and out the motif or edge.

The reason for this is the fact that that those pairs don't stay together, but every thread is going diagonal throught the motif or edge. The line for the workers of course is showing only the way the working thread is going, because also the workers don't stay together.
